■ **ADMISSION FEE** (One-time fee for new students)

Fee per student that is paid only once upon joining our community.

1st Child	\$15,000.00
2nd Child	\$11,250.00
3rd Child	\$7,500.00

Discount:

6% for single-installment payment before December 21st, 2020

What does admission fee cover?

This fee is used for infrastructure and special projects that enrich our educational approach.

■ **REGISTRATION FEE**

Annual fee per student. Registration is open year-round. The fee is paid proportionally to the percentage of the school year to be completed by the student.

Financing:

Plan A: Maximum 10 monthly payments or until June 20th, 2021, whichever comes first. The interest rate is from 4 to 8 percent, depending on the term. Payments must be made before the 20th of each month.

Plan B: Initial payment of 50% followed by a maximum of 10 subsequent monthly payments, or until June 20th, 2021, whichever comes first. The interest rate is from 2 to 4 percent, depending on the term. Payments must be made before the 20th of each month.

Discount:

6% for single-installment payment before December 21st, 2020

What does the registration fee cover?

- Accident Insurance for your child

■ TUITON (includes meals)

Tuition is paid in **11 monthly payments** per student during the school year.

Tuition **includes lunch and a snack each day** (mainly organic foods) based on a menu designed by a specialist in child nutrition.

Discounts:

Between 3 and 6 percent discount for early single-installment payment, depending on the term. Tuition payments must be made within the first ten days of each month.

What does tuition cover?

- An educational approach based on one of the most renowned pedagogies in the world, from Reggio Emilia, Italy.
- Salaries of highly qualified and experienced teachers. A large percentage of our teachers received their education in English-speaking countries.
- Small groups for more personalized attention.
- Atelier and atelierista specialized in the languages of plastic and audiovisual arts.
- Rigorous documentation and analysis of the children's cognitive and social processes.
- Continuous training for teachers and support staff.
- Educational activities in partnership with Rancho La Luna, a leader in permaculture.
- Spaces and materials carefully selected to cover the pedagogic needs of our educational approach.
- **Lunch each day (menu designed by a nutrition specialist and prepared with care, cleanliness, and love by our cook).**
- **Snack upon arriving at school for children that request it.**
- Use of dishes and utensils, demonstrating our trust and respect for our students (no plastic or disposable plates or cups).
- Nutritional education for our students, who will be exposed to an appropriate diet so that they acquire healthy eating habits and develop environmental awareness, consuming products that are local and in season.
- Planting, maintenance, and harvest of our organic gardens.

PAYMENT POLICIES

1. Fees are stipulated in Mexican pesos.
 2. Tuition must be paid within the first ten days of each month.
 3. Admissions and Tuition monthly fees must be paid before the 20th of each month.
 4. Payments made after these dates will have an additional 4% charge calculated in proportion of the late-payment days.
 5. Payment with a check returned for insufficient funds will generate a 20% fee, as stipulated in the Law of Titles and Operations. The family will cover the charge with another form of payment, and will not be able to pay by check thereafter.
 6. In order to have access to a payment plan, families must abide to their payment obligations in time and form, complete the financial application, adjoin the required documentation and sign the promissory note, which will guarantee the compliance to the commitment acquired through the payment plan.
 7. Payments in tuition or in a payment plan must be up-to-date in order to enroll in the following school cycle.
 8. If the family owes of tuition and/or financed payments, educational services will be suspended and the student will not be allowed to enter the campus at Habitat Learning Community, until the payment has been completed.
 9. If the student will not be enrolling in the next school year, the family must give written notice of their decision at least two months prior to the beginning of the school year in order to receive a tuition reimbursement. In case of not abiding with the former, no reimbursement will be issued.
 10. Eleven (11) monthly tuition payments must be made beginning in August of the corresponding school year (or by means of single installment payment), regardless of when the student begins to attend school.
 11. If a family requests enrollment after the beginning of the school year (**subject to availability**), the initial assistance and tuition payment are agreed and signed upon contract. The first tuition payment must be made on the agreed date, and subsequent payments must be made as well, even in the case in which the family may decide for the student to begin attending school later than the agreed starting date.
